Located on the Gulf of Mexico, Naples receives lots of sun with average highs hovering around 90 F and lows in the high 60's from May-September. Summer is the rainy season with about 8 inches of rainfall per month. Activities in the area include water/ocean sports, golf, concerts, fine dining, or visits to the many local parks. Naples is also very close to the Everglades, a series of swampy islands known for its wide array of wildlife. Naples has a new public transportation system consisting of buses that run Monday-Saturday, 6am-7pm.

Vero Beach is located in on the Atlantic coast of Florida. There are many things to do and see in the area, including water and outdoor activities and visits to the McKee Botanical Garden, the Mel Fisher Treasure Museum, and the Navy SEAL Museum. Less than two hour's drive is Walt Disney World and Universal Studios, Sea World, and the Kennedy Space Center. There is no public transportation in Vero Beach. The area experiences hot summers with average temperatures in the 80's.

Known for its beaches, this city is located on the Atlantic Ocean. There are many parks and museums to visit, including the Morikami Museum and Japanese Gardens, which draws over 150,000 visitors annually. Public transportation is not very efficient but there is limited bus service, as well as a free shuttle bus service in its downtown area. Bike rentals are also available at Richwagen's Cycle Center. During summer the average temperatures are in the 80's.

Miami is located in Southeast Florida between the Everglades and the Atlantic Ocean. As a major US city, there is very good public transportation system consisting of bus lines and a rapid transit Metrorail system. There are many things to do and see including visits to the beach, the Museum of Contemporary Art, or Zoo Miami. The city is also home to professional sports teams such as the Heat (basketball) and the Dolphins (football). Miami has hot, humid summers with average temperatures between 79 F and 88 F.

West Palm Beach is located on the Atlantic coast of Florida. There are lots of cultural events and entertainment opportunities. Sunfest, a music, art, and waterfront festival, takes place the first week of each May and draws in over 275,000 people. Public transportation consists of buses and includes free trolley service in the downtown area. There is also a tri-rail commuter train connecting the city with Miami and Fort Lauderdale. Summers are hot, humid and wet, with average temperatures of 86 – 90 F.
